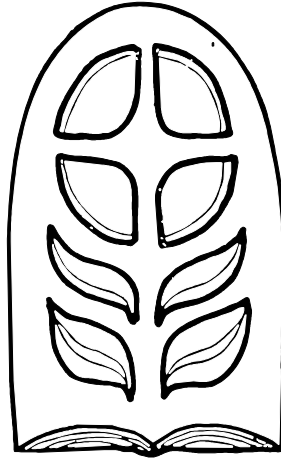


Reformed Theology Course
