An invitation for readers to look within and develop an approach to the Lenten journey that is authentic, fresh, and relevant. Includes reflection questions, group exercises and list of Lenten practices.

**Destination Easter!** by Kathy Hershman Lenten programs and practices for youth. Handouts included on a disk.

**Did Christians Invent Judas?** by John Shelby Spong Spong wonders if Christians invented Judas to transfer blame for Jesus' death from the Romans to the Jews some time in the last half of the first century.

**Discovering the Empty Tomb** The story follows Jesus from his triumphant entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday to his resurrection on Easter morning. Host David Mead explains the action and poses questions in a fresh way.

Dying to Live by James Harnish Seven session study on atonement with questions for individual or group reflection.

People must rely on faith and grace to see them through. Each chapter is based on a Gospel text about a person's journey.

Gospelled Lives by John Indermark Meet New Testament individual who heard Jesus speak a word about their life. This 6 week study is for small group or individuals.

Jesus, the Final Days by Craig Evans Evans and NT. Wright discern historically what really did happen in Jesus' final days.

Lent 2004 The Way of the Cross by John Hargis A 7 week study from Luke on the way of the cross.

Lent 2005 Savior on a Cross by David Kalas 7 sessions look at the image of the cross, why the symbol is appropriate for God's good news, God's sacrifice, God's love. Leader's Guide and Student Book.

Lent by Megan McKenna Reflections and stories on daily readings which show us how to imitate Jesus today.

Life in His Name by Elaine Ward This pamphlet contains a Scripture and meditation suggestion from the Gospel of John for the days of Lent.

Living with the Mind of Christ by James Harnish Each of 7 lessons includes Scripture, reflection questions and prayer.

Miriam's Sisters Rejoice by Diane Neu A telling of the Passover story from the feminist perspective of Christian and Jewish women. It tells the story of women's journey from oppression to liberation.

Mission: Easter by Todd Outcalt 10 sessions for youth on Lent, Holy Week and Easter.

On a Friday Noon by Hans-Ruedi Weber An illustrated devotional book, artists depict what happened the day Jesus was crucified. The text is from Scripture, liturgies, hymns, poems. The art is from Byzantine to 20th century times.

On the Road Again by James Moore Some of Jesus' most powerful experiences happened on the road. This 7 session study on faith journey includes Scripture, reading, questions, and prayer.

One Who Was There by Suzy Loftis In 64 AD, a weary woman, waiting for Jesus return, sets out from Jerusalem to Galilee and is transformed along the way by 2nd generation Christians. As she looks back on her life, she realizes the possibility of new beginnings. VIDEO

Out of Easter, The Gospels by Jean Hall Teaches methods and skills for reading the Gospels. An introduction to forms: parable narrative, sayings, images. Leader's guide and student book.

Passage Through Sacred History by Don Skinner Lenten reflections for individuals and groups based on Scripture from Abram and Sarai to the death and resurrection of Jesus.

Radical Renovation: Living the Cross-shaped Life by James Harnish A seven session study which may allow god to reshape people's lives in order to live into the likeness of Jesus. Each session includes Scripture reference, reflection, questions for discussion, prayer.

Reading the Gospel with Jewish Eyes by John Shelby Spong The events of Jesus' life seem to closely follow an orderly cycle of Jewish feasts and rites of passage not so much memory, biography or history.

Resurrection by Rowan Williams Shows how the experience of Jesus' resurrection was from the first an experience of forgiveness and of the healing of memories of injury, guilt or failure. It allows a new understanding of God.

Synago Hope at the Cross by Anne Broyles 16 sessions for students or adults to lead for youth to strengthen their faith and build community. 1.5 hour sessions include socializing, opening, warm-up, topic talk, word search, reflect and respond, wrap-up, celebrations and concerns and closing.

The Common People :Heard Him Gladly by James Moore A 7 session study about why did Jesus resonate with the common folks and how did he communicate so deeply.

The Death and Resurrection of Jesus by Marcus Borg Borg directs the viewer away from doctrine to a relationship through Jesus with God. 6 - 20 min. sessions include What happened good Friday? What happened at Easter, Jesus is Lord, Jesus is the way, Jesus as sacrifice, Jesus, God's Love revealed.

The Golgotha Earthquake by Paul Servier An examination of 3 texts on the crucifixion and the continuing relevance of the event at Golgotha.

The Last Days of Jesus by Francois Bovon Looking at the passion narratives of the four Gospels and Peter, Bovon shows that the stories are reflections of the perspectives of those who wrote them.

The Passion and Death of Jesus by John P. Gilbert A 7 session study of the most difficult period of Jesus' life: what we know as Holy Week. Includes study helps and reflection questions.

The Pre-Easter Jesus by Marcus Borg A sketch of Jesus is drawn with five broad strokes, each of which identifies a central characteristic of Jesus : the

ecstatic, healer, wisdom teacher, prophet and movement initiator.

The Passover Seder by Emily Sper A touch, turn, open and learn story of the Jewish Seder.

The Resurrected Life 4 part video offers practical insight into the transformational aspects of the Resurrection on a personal, intimate level that can affect profound changes in individual lives.

The Resurrection of Jesus: Hoax or History? by Gerd Ludemann Ludemann offers his honest answer to the questions about the resurrection.

The Risen Savior by Philip Bence 7 session study on gospels of Mark and John about faith.

The Servant King by Paula Clifford Reflections for Lent using images from artists around the world, reflections and prayers.

The Seven Next Words of Christ by Shane Stanford The author breathes life into the Easter faith with his exploration of the Seven Next Words of Christ full of resurrection surprise and vitality. Includes study guide.

and Pray Lent 2006 by Lee Franklin A Lenten study based on the revised common lectionary.

**Mr. Pascal** by Alison De Vere A cobbler pines for happier years past. He takes Jesus from the cross and the revived Christ welcomes the street people. Mr. Pascal dreams that the tree of life sprouts from the ashes of his church yard fire. The messages of hope are timeless.

**Nanny and Isaiah: Easter Today, Easter Forever** by Carol Greene Nanny loses a special friend...Isaiah doesn't make the school play...Mrs. MacTuggle has a bad cold. Yet Nanny and Isaiah have the best Easter ever!

**One Morning in Joseph's Garden** by Barbara Younger A retelling of the resurrection story.

**Phos: The Light** A classic story about the life-style of a Greek village preparing for the Easter celebration and the anxieties of a fatherless boy. The boy struggles to be the first to receive the new light.
