NOT FOR SALE CAMPAIGN – FREEDOM SUNDAY, February 21, 2010

27 Million People live in slavery around the world today. The Not For Sale Campaign, an active abolitionist movement, is asking people of faith, specifically church leaders, to preach on the topics of Freedom and Anti-Slavery on Sunday, February 21, 2010. They are sending this request to all clergy of all faiths so that we can show a united front against slavery, and specifically human trafficking on Freedom Sunday.

Eric Goodwin, a program coordinator in the Harvard University Provost's Office working in the global health initiatives human trafficking program has asked that clergy share their commitment and intention to preach on these issues on Freedom Sunday, so that they can track who participates.
